THE LVR INDUSTRIAL MUSEUM – CROMFORD TEXTILE MILL

Located in Ratingen: the first factory on the European Continent. The cotton spinning mill, established in 1783/84 by the Wuppertal merchant Johann Gottfried Brügelmann, now serves as the site of the museum. In the historic factory and the manor house, visitors are invited to immerse themselves in the living and working environments of the 18th century. The museum is also distinguished by its special exhibitions dedicated to the cultural history of clothing and fashion. Furthermore, an extensive museum education program is offered, including guided tours, workshops, and children's birthday celebrations.
